It has been my pleasure to serve the Central Bay District as your registrar for the past few years. As my time in elected office was coming to a close, I knew I

would miss the camaraderie of the leadership team. So when I heard that Ele Hunt was "retiring" from the role of registrar, I had my answer: I stepped up to take this position, which is "appointed" rather than "elected." I am hoping someone in the district will now be willing to do the same when I step down at the end of 2025.

So I thought I'd share what it takes to serve as registrar.

Of course, it takes someone who pays attention to detail: keeping track of the registration forms and the names of members from each unit attending an event, along with the checks. It takes someone willing to respond to emails and phone calls with questions. And to be gracious when you receive a plea to add one more name after the deadline. (I haven't ever turned anyone down, but don't let that secret out!)

It takes someone who works well with others: informing the host unit of the number of attendees, along with the spiritual growth coordinator(s), copresidents, secretary and vice president. It also means keeping the communications coordinator in the loop so she knows how many programs to print. It means passing the checks along to the district treasurer. And the registrar assigns rooms for the retreat at The Springs.

And being registrar obviously means providing name tags. But it's so much more than that! When you check everyone in at the registration table, it means greeting people warmly. It's a great way to match names with faces and get to know wonderful women beyond your local unit.

When the Nominations Committee calls, say "yes!" to this opportunity. In the meantime, I hope to see you at our district events.
