From the District Treasurer...

First let me welcome all the new units who are now a part of the Greater Southwest Michigan District of United Women in Faith. I sent out emails to all church secretaries in our district a few weeks ago, asking for information about local units of UWF. I appreciate the responses I have received so far. I recently sent out a follow up letter and form to each unit (old and new) asking for information about your local unit, officers and contact information. I only received about 12 responses to the initial email so am trying again and hope to hear from more of you. Thanks for taking the time to fill it out and return it to me so that I can update mailing lists, etc. What I am really hoping to find out is how many active units we have and whether units that might currently be inactive are interested in a visit from someone on the leadership team to talk about rebuilding or maybe just rejuvenating your unit. You can contact me or any of the district officers at any time and we would be happy to help.

We are in the 3rd quarter of our fiscal year so *please* send in your pledges as soon as you can do so. I would also encourage all of you to consider becoming a 5 Channel Giving unit. The areas for giving are Pledge to Mission, Special Mission Recognition, Gift to Mission, Gift in Memory and World Thank Offering. I have a good supply of cards for Gift to Mission, In Service of Christ, birthdays, and new baby and recently got a new supply of Gift in Memory cards. To receive any card, a pledge of \$5 is needed in one of 4 channels (Special Mission Recognition is a \$40 pledge and a pin is sent). Any single member of your unit can also give personally to all 5 areas and be recognized as a 5 Star Person. This is considered part of your unit pledge, and the unit is then automatically a 5 Channel Unit. There is a specific form for 5 Star Person so please contact me if you would like one.

Please let me know if you have any questions or need anything from me, including forms. I am happy to help.


