A note from the District Treasurer...

It is hard to believe we are already in the 4th quarter of our fiscal year but in reality, District Celebration and Annual Conference are in the past and we are at the end of our fiscal year. The final quarter is always like a race for me, working to keep up to date with local units' remittances and close out the books for 2024.

As of the end of the 3rd quarter, total remittances from local units are \$13,553.21. This is about average for this time of year, which is encouraging but our total pledge to mission is \$35,000 so we have a lot to make up in these final months. If your unit has not sent its annual remittance, please do so as soon as possible and if your unit is considering an increase, this is a good time to do it. My "drop dead" date for having remittances included in the 2024 overall budget is Monday **DECEMBER 9.** Remittances received after that date will be held over for the 2025 budget. Please make sure you have sent yours by that date **and well before if possible**.
