Taking Inventory

When I was in my early teens, **many** decades ago, I was delighted to participate in the annual inventory at the large-for-the-time auto supply company where my dad was employed as a jobber salesman. Most of the employees and family members were enlisted to do the yearly count of the contents of many aisles of the parts department. I was fascinated by the nuts, bolts, screws, washers, cables, belts, sparkplugs, wrenches, screwdrivers, tires, caps, tire irons, tubes, patches, bulbs, batteries, cleaners, waxes, lubricants, wipers, filters, covers, cushions, mirrors, *etc*.

We worked in pairs; one person often on a ladder to reach and count the shelved containers and the other standing below to record the number of items on paper tablets. I understood it was important to do this annual tally. (Nowadays, I am likely to observe a single grocery employee taking inventory with a barcode reader. How efficient, but so lonely!)

United Women in Faith has an annual "inventory" of sorts. It is the Mission Today Objectives report form. It is found on the Michigan Conference UWF website. (Which is still at https://www.umwmichiganconference.org/)

So far I have received only four unit reports for 2022. (Thank you!) We honored seven units for their accomplishments in 2021 at our 2022 UWF Heritage District Annual Meeting in October. There must be more units who have accomplished the goals for at least a "Faith" award. There is still time to "take inventory"! Do send your report by February 1st. If you do not want to look backward, use the form to jump-start 2023 programs, set goals, create some new projects, attend Mission u, plan a trip to United Methodist Community House, read *response* magazine, or start a book group using titles from the Reading Program. (Did you know that you can get reading credit for participating in "Faith Talks" on line?)

Aren't you glad we don't have to literally climb ladders to take inventory? We have tools to communicate, hands to lighten the load when we join with others, hearts that love and care, heads that can think new thoughts, and souls that are joined in Christ who strengthens us.
