Mid-Michigan District United Methodist Women First Annual Celebration Green Street United Methodist Church September 18, 2019

Mid-Michigan District United Methodist Women held their First Annual Celebration. Joyce Plumhoff, assisted by Bernice Natoli, began registration at 9:00 am with 86 in attendance. Members of the Mid-Michigan District Mission Team in attendance were: Donna Kleiver, Sharon Smith, Joyce Plumhoff, Bernice Natoli, Karol Fry, Judy Marr, Jackie Ricketts, Nancy Nay, Pat Mentzer, Beverly Saunders and WalthaGaye Leavitt. Conference Mission Coordinator for Membership Nurture and Outreach Patricia Snyder was also present.

The program started with the song Be Bold/ Be Strong by DVD and words on the overhead.

Judy Marr presented her devotion on the scripture II John 1-6 and the book series, Sensible Shoes.

Sharon then welcomed everyone present. She introduced the pastor of the church, Rev. Bryce Feighner who blessed us with a brief history and what their church is doing. Donna Mathews, President of Green Street UMW gave us a few housekeeping details. Rev. Dr. Jerry DeVine, District Superintendent, gave us a few words about his almost 40-year history as an honorary member of the UMW and what that meant and means now. Linda Darrow, Michigan Conference President, was introduced and briefly pointed out the new banner of Districts. She also talked about the difficulty of combining the conferences and going forward. Linda then invited us to the Conference Annual October 26th at Howell and NCJ in Sioux Falls, S.D.

The Past Presidents were introduced. Those in attendance were Kathleen Wagner, Ruth Whaley, Leta Guild, Joyce Plumhoff and WalthaGaye Leavitt. Letters were read from Maudie Williams and Ruth Turner. Retired Missionaries in attendance were Bill and Rose Bauer and Dorothy Frederickson.

There being no changes, the program was accepted.

Donna and Pat Snyder presented the Memorial Service. Patricia read a scripture before names were called. A battery-operated candle was then lit as the church name was called and those present stood. The service was ended with a reading and a prayer.

Special Music was provided by a trio of Green Street UMW members accompanied by a guitar from their church. The music was "Nobody Loves Me Like You Love Me, Jesus.

Linda Darrow, the keynote speaker, was introduced by Sharon. Her topic was taken from the book by J.D. Jakes, God's Leading Lady, and II John 1-6. Her journey began in college as a member of Kappa Phi which naturally transitioned into leadership roles in church and UMW. The question that she left us with is: "why aren't more women fulfilling their dreams and doing what God intended?"

After the Hymn Standing on the Promises, Linda Darrow explained to us what is going on currently with the Legacy Fund. Since the goal has not been reached, the deadline of the fund giving has been extended. They are encouraging us to be Legacy Builders and give \$18.69/month to get to the goal.

WalthaGaye then invited all to the Mission u of the North in October. She stressed that with 4 sites, everyone should be able to get to one. The topics were given.

Happy Birthday was sung to Elaine Garlock who turned 99 today. Then we were dismissed (15 minutes early) to go to Leadership training or Book Chat and then to lunch. Grace was given at each training session.

At 12:45 pm after a delicious potato bar, jello salad, fresh vegies and cookies provided by the Green Street UMW, the meeting resumed. Ethalyn Walker and Patsy Coffman were recognized as Past Presidents of Heartland District.

God of Grace, and God of Glory was sung as people gathered. Pat M., Jackie and Karol presented the Reading Program awards. The Five Channels of giving certificates were handed out to those in the program plus Carson City UMC, Alma UMC, St. Louis UMC and Dewitt Redeemer of St. Johns UMC.

Eric Williams, CEO of UMCH and Carla Moore, COO of UMCH, updated us on what is happening. The United Methodist Community House is 118 years old and cares for 2-year old children to Seniors. Thanks to the UMW of Grand Rapids area, it was the first to start a preschool and a Meals on Wheels for Seniors. They are looking for a better way to do things to keep up with and prepare for the future by collaborating with area agencies to maximize resources and provide assistance to a greater number.

Sharon introduced our next speaker Julia Skinner, member of the Board of Directors of Soaring Unlimited Haiti. She showed us slides of the Mission House in Cap Haitian. There is new a transformer which means that there is now reliable electricity 24 hours/day. Some nearby businesses can utilize their power also. Soaring Unlimited provides schools, uniforms, teachers, schoolbooks, books for their libraries, tables and chairs, and leadership classes for young adults. They also operate a Medical Clinic in Pister with a Doctor and Pharmacist on site. It is now open 5 days a week. There is space to hold classes in family planning, prenatal and post-natal care, nutrition, and infant care where the new parents receive a baby box filled with items needed in their first weeks. In November, they hope to start construction on the new Women's health and Birthing Center. The land is currently being cleared and then a fence will be erected to keep those working safe as the country has periods of unrest. Workers and supplies will be from the area as much as possible. The plan is to partner with the University of Michigan Medical school to get a supply of doctors and nurses to care for the people. The first class of midwives has graduated and is working. Last year they assisted at 81 births with no deaths to mothers or babies.

After reciting the PURPOSE together, Donna Kleiver called the Annul Business meeting to order at 2:45 pm. WalthaGaye, acting Secretary, presented the minutes of the 2018 Mid-Michigan District Organizational Meeting. She then presented the Standing Rules. They were approved at the December 5, 2018 meeting of the Leadership Team. The Standing Rules were presented from the Committee. All in favor, no opposed and no abstentions. Motion carried.

Jackie, Treasurer presented the A and MD budget for 2020. The total budget for the 2020 year is \$8,975.00 and the proposed Pledge to Mission is \$40,000. There were no questions. All were in favor, no opposed and no abstentions. Carried.

Chairperson of Committee on Nominations, Bernice presented the 2020 Mid –Michigan District Leadership Team as follows: Donna Kleiver, President; Sharon Smith, Vice President; Rita Baird, Secretary; Jackie Ricketts, Treasurer; Judy Marr, Mission Coordinator for Spiritual Growth; Nancy Nay, Mission Coordinator for Social Action; Karol Fry, Mission Coordinator for Education and Interpretation and Program Resources; Patti Puckett, Membership Nurture and Outreach; Bernice Natoli, Linda Huyck, and Beverly Saunders, Committee on Nominations. Appointed positions include Elaine Ferris, Green Team and Joyce Plumhoff, Registrar. Lynda Crandall has agreed to be Editor of The Messenger for 2020. Each person stood as their name was called. As there were no nominations from the floor, the slate was adopted as presented by unanimous vote.

Pat Mentzer is going off the team this year. She was recognized with a pin. Evelyn Bochenek is unable to continue in her role. She will receive a Gift to Mission.

An offering of \$1003.13 was collected to be divided between UMCH and Soaring Unlimited Haiti. The Ingathering of non-perishable food items and paper products was collected for the Barry County Food Bank.

After a hymn, Julia Paradine-Rice, Conference Treasurer, presided over the Installation of the newly elected slate of Officers.

Barbara Hagen, on behalf of St. Louis First UMC invited us to the next Annual Celebration at their church Wednesday, September 16, 2020.

Rev. Bryce Feighner led us in Holy Communion followed by the benediction. Everyone then sang Be Bold/Be Strong before leaving at 2:38 pm.
